 Online Reservation System

Use the Online Reservation System to search for available Book Group in a Bag kits and manage your reservations online.

Overview

You can reserve Book Group in a Bag kits up to 18 months in advance. During your reservation's six week range, you may pick up and return your Book Group in a Bag kit at the Reference Desk in the library. The loan period is for 6 weeks, to allow group leaders to distribute the books on a monthly group schedule and collect at the next meeting. Book kits must be returned by the due date so they can be provided to the next book group. Late fees for Book Group in a Bag kits are \$1 per day up to a maximum of \$10.

NEW! Same Day Reservation and Pick Up

Titles labeled Available Now are available for immediate pickup. Ask for help at the Reference Desk.

Using the Reservation System

Register or Login with your library barcode and PIN. To place a reservation, check title availability by clicking on each book in the Online Reservation System. Available dates to begin a 6 week reservation are displayed in green. Click on the start date for your reservation. You may designate any Authorized Users at that time if you want a friend to be able to pick up the kit on your behalf. To change the start date of a reservation, you should cancel your first reservation and place a new reservation with the new start date.
