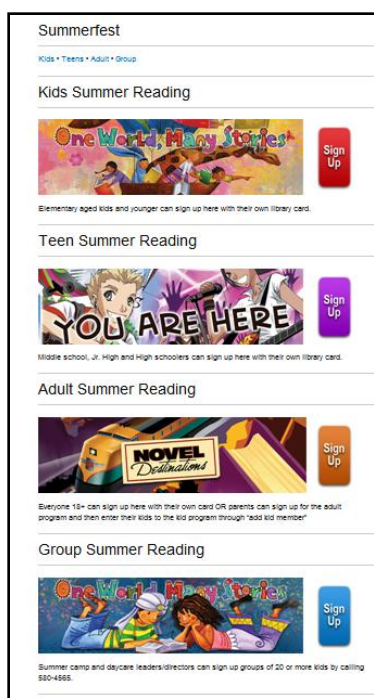

Reading Goals and Prizes

Kids and Teens earn coupons for food and fun from local businesses for every 2 hours up to 16 hours. At 12 hours you will earn your completion certificate and be entered in a drawing for a Nook eReader.

THREE options for daycare/camp groups

- **GROUP option** -Best option for groups of 20 children or more
- **ADULT with ADD KID MEMBER option** – for groups of fewer than 12 children, all registered under a teacher’s library card. *
- **KID option** – for groups of any size, in which each kid uses their own library card to participate**

**For groups of 12-19 children, the library recommends either splitting into groups of less than 12 kids per teacher’s card or using the KID option for each child.*

***Any child who is registered through their camp or daycare as GROUP or*

ADULT with ADD KID MEMBER will still be eligible to also participate using their own library card.

Timeline

- May 4th until May 31- Registration ONLY, program starts May 31
- July 23 – Registration ends
- **May 31-July 29 (noon)** – read books or listen to others read you books and track your hours on the online reading log
- July 30 - Grand prize drawing announcements on the library website
- July 30 - last day to pick up your prizes at the library

GROUP option

- For a daycare or camp setting of 20 kids or more, the group leader should call 580-4565 to register directly with library staff. You will need your daycare contact information and the number of kids participating in your group.
- Throughout the summer, the leader will then log in under the GROUP tab to track the time for the entire group, and collect the prizes for the entire group. *For example, as a group, if your camp has 27 children, you would log the 2 hours of reading time that all 27 kids completed, and then collect the 27 prizes for the 27 children.*
- The children in a GROUP need not be present for the leader to pick up the prizes at the Youth Services Desk or Bookmobile. Call ahead to 785-580-4565 for fast and easy service to pick up your prizes.

ADULT with ADD KID MEMBER option

- For groups of less than 12 kids. The teacher should first register as a reader in the adult program, and then "ADD KID MEMBER" when prompted to register each child. Teens register under TEEN option.
- The teacher will track the reading time for each child and pick up the prizes for each child.

- The children using the ADULT with ADD KID MEMBER option need not be present for the adult to pick up the prizes at the Youth Services Desk or Bookmobile. Call ahead to 785-580-4565 for fast and easy service to pick up your prizes.

KID option

Any child (babies, toddlers, preschoolers and kids in elementary school) with a library card

TEEN option

Any teen (Middle School, Junior High and High School students) with a library card

ADULT option

Any adult with a library card

General information

- The system requires a library card and PIN.
- Create a username and use it or your barcode to access your account and earn prizes.
- Add time or view your progress by logging in and clicking "Add/View" button.
- Prizes are reserved for you automatically as you reach each reading goal.
- Prizes MUST be picked up at the library or on a bookmobile.
- Grade level Pre-K is used for everyone under school age through birth. Grade is always the grade they are going INTO in the fall. Adult age is to help us with stats.
- The Quantity box is labeled in hours. If you want to record a smaller amount, 30 minutes = 0.5 hours. 15 minutes = 0.25 hours.
