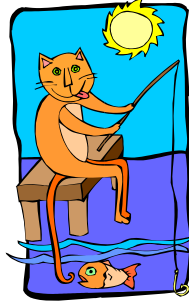


Make & Take Crafts: Today it's all about FISH

Let's Buy a Goldfish

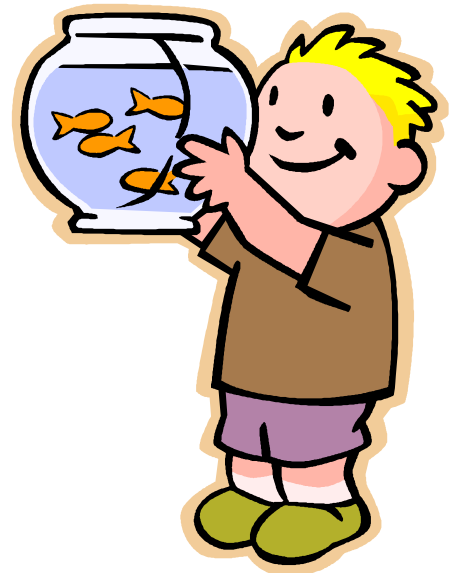
Five little goldfish at the pet store,

I want this one for my teacher and now there is just ONE!

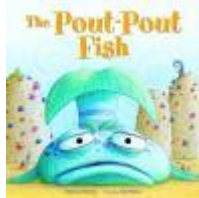
One little goldfish swimming all alone,

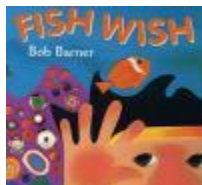

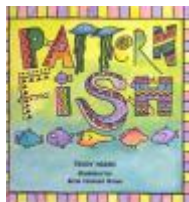

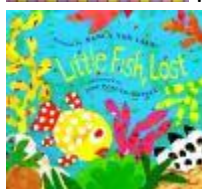
