

E-Books @ TSCPL

How to download and use e-books from the Overdrive Service with your Topeka and Shawnee County Public Library Card

Note: These instructions are written for use with a Barnes & Noble Nook. Ebooks can be used with many readers including the Sony readers, Kobo reader, Pandigital reader and many smart phones using the Android app, the Ipad/Iphone app, and Blackberry system.

You will need:

- A TSCPL library card
- A personal computer with an internet connection and speakers or headphones
- Adobe Digital Editions (instructions for installing at the end of this document)

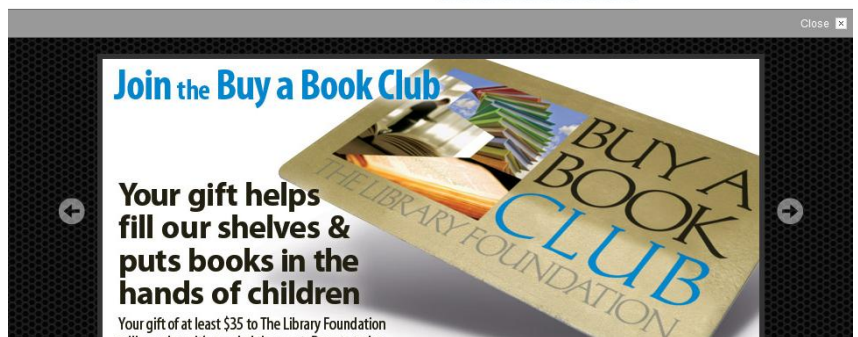
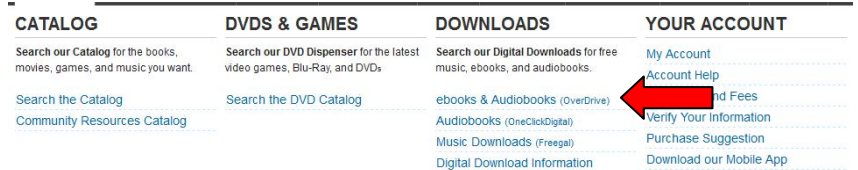
Optional: A portable device, such as a Sony Reader, Nook, or Kobo (these instructions will use the Nook)

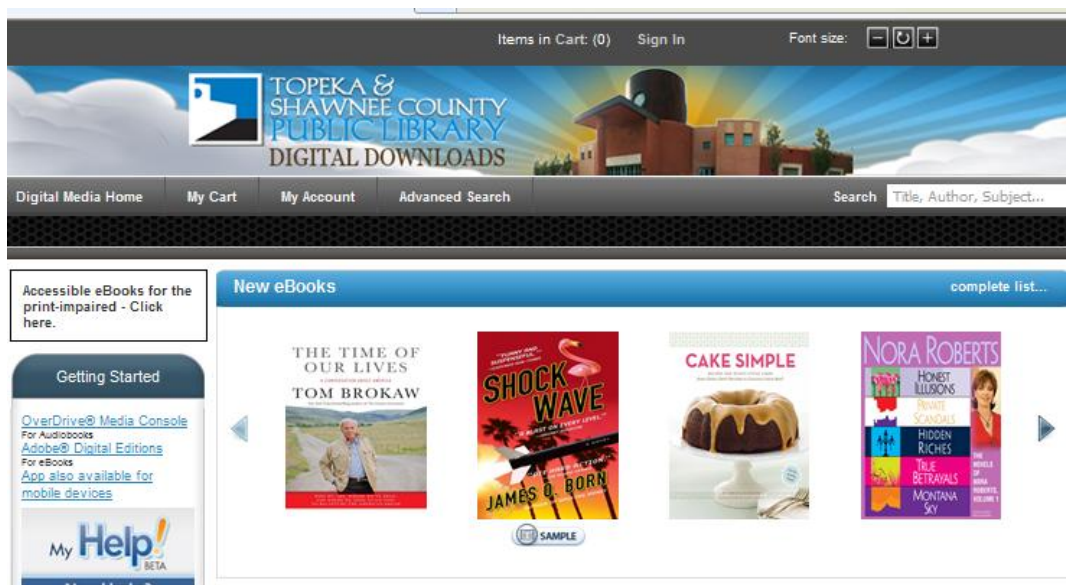

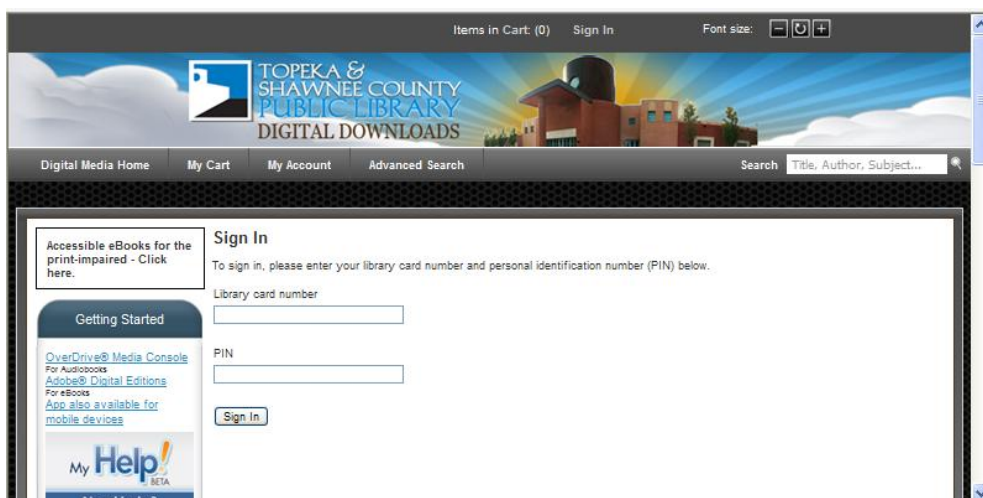
Before you start browsing for books you can sign in with your library card so that you are ready to check things out. Look for the “**sign in**” link on the top of the screen.



Sign in with your TSCPL library card.

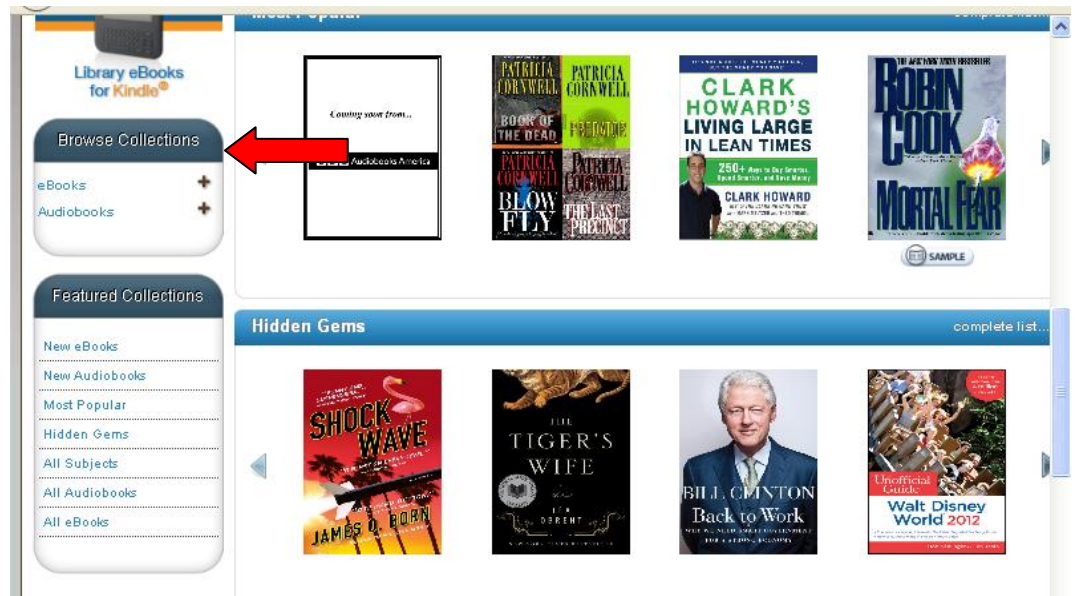
In the first box type your entire barcode number from the back of your card (with no spaces).

In the next box type in your **4 digit PIN** number (which for most patrons is the last four digits of your phone number).



Now you need to find something to check out.

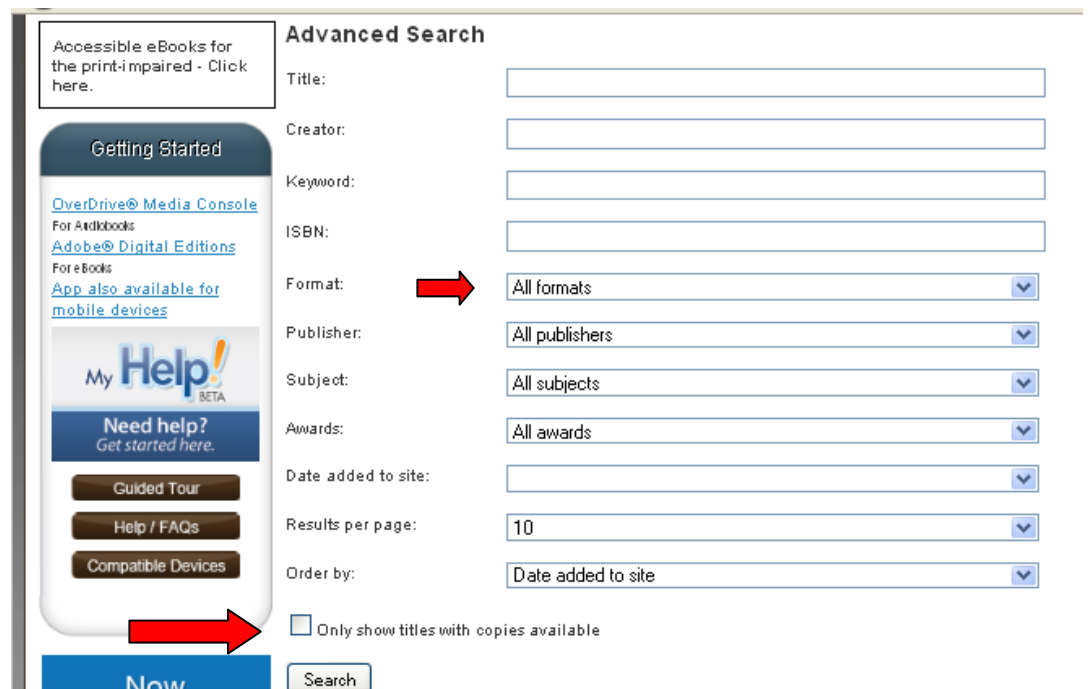
Scroll down on the page and there is a link on the left side of the page under Browse Collections you can click e-books. This brings up an unsorted list of all e-book titles.



Or you can click on Advance Search

To open up search features that includes searching by **creator, title, and format** (Only Adobe E-Pub or Adobe PDF e-books will work with the E- Readers Kindle books works only with Kindle). Choose one of these formats and you can also check the box that says **“Only show available titles”** to get a list of all the e-books currently available for check-out.

NOTE: Use only **one** format at a time on your device Adobe E-Pub or Adobe PDF (An error in reading the files can happen if both formats are loaded onto the device at the same time).



When you see an item you like, click on the title or book cover icon to see its detailed record.

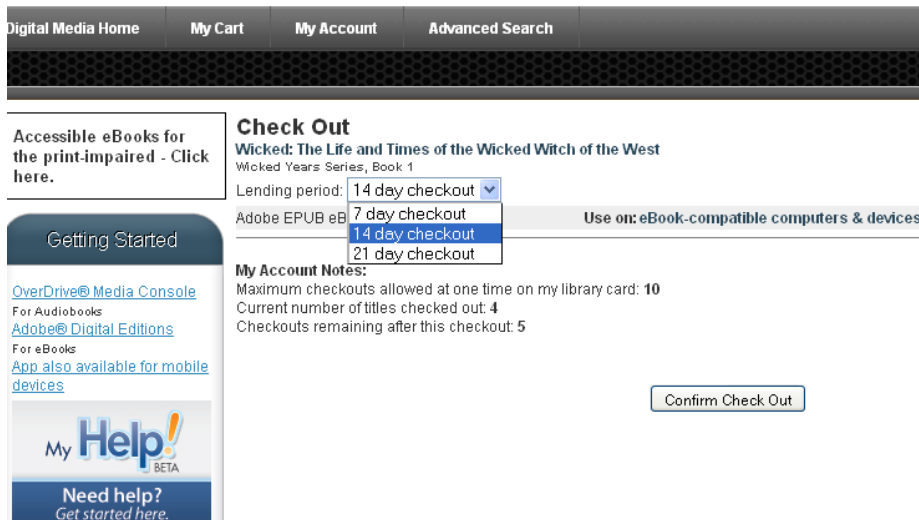

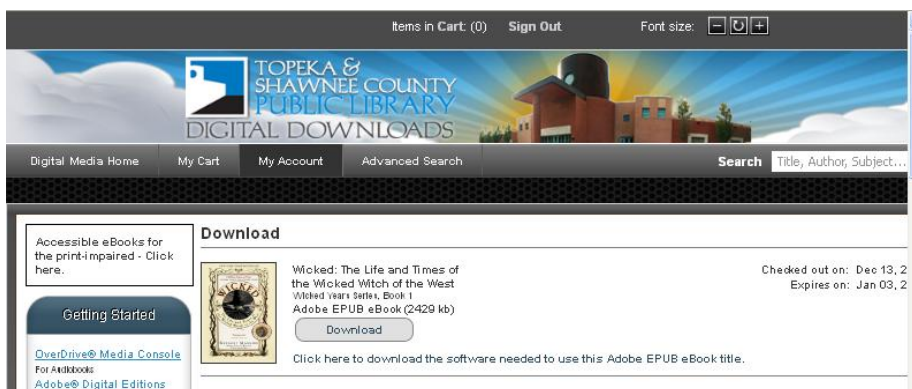
Continue Browsing **→ Proceed to Checkout**

The “check out” screen that appears will have a spot where you can choose your lending period—click on the drop down arrow and choose 7, 14 or 21 days.

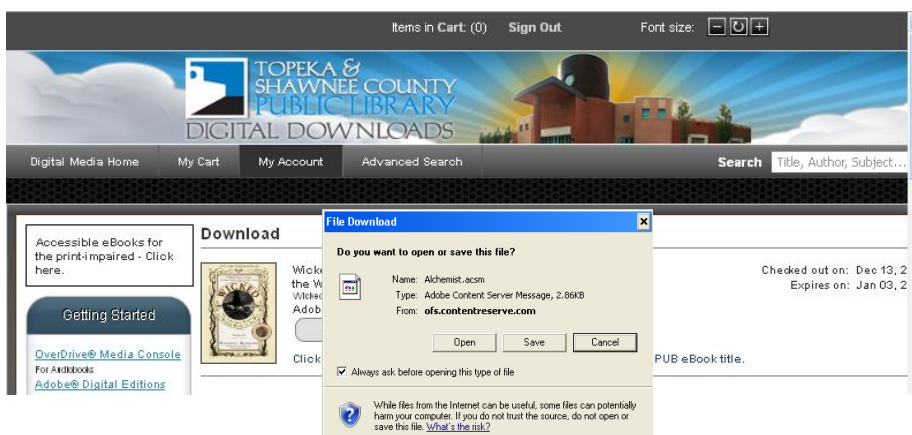
Then click on “confirm checkout” to get to the download page.



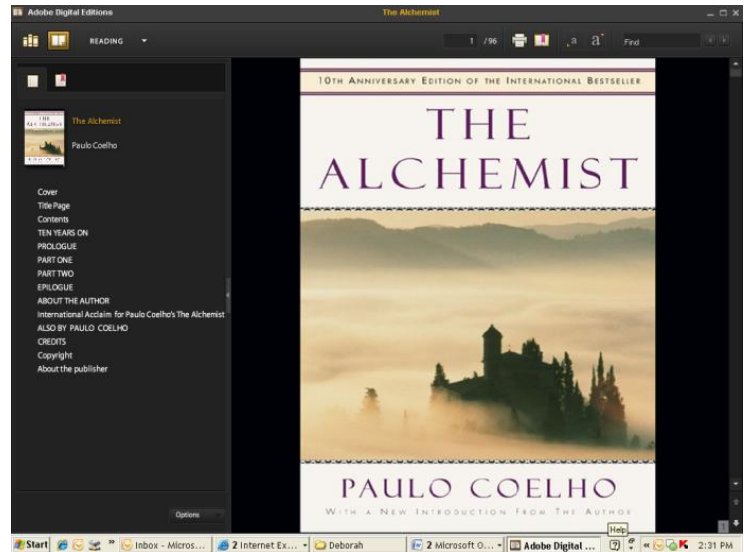
You will then see the download page. To start downloading the e-book simply click on the “download” button.



A dialog box will pop up asking you if you want to open or save the file. Either will work, but clicking on “open” will save you a step. Click on “open” and the file will download.



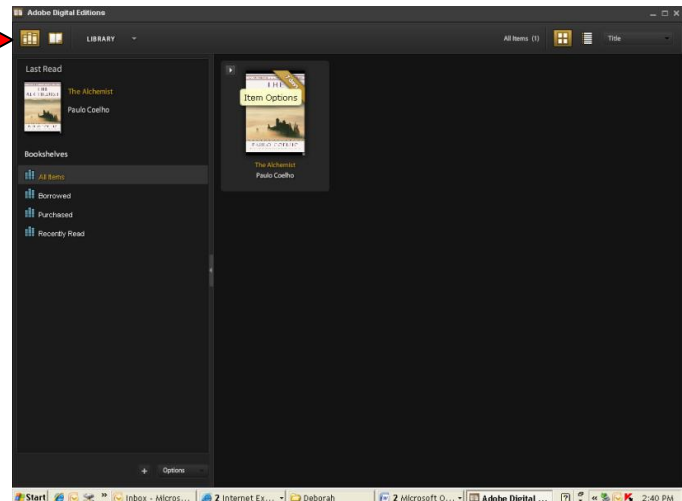
Adobe Digital Editions should open up and display your e-book for you in the reading view. Now you can read the book in Adobe Digital Editions on your computer, laptop, or net book.



Transferring Files:

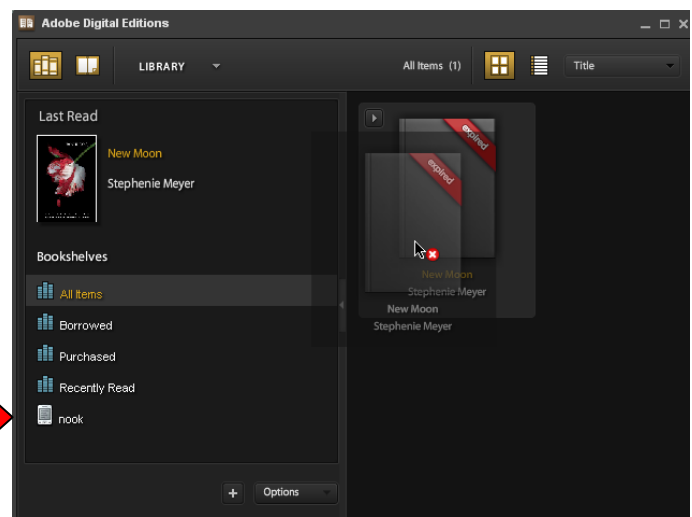


You can transfer your e-book to a portable reading device such as a Sony Reader or Nook. First click on the icon that looks like 3 books in the upper left corner of the Adobe Digital Editions Screen. This will take you to the “library” view. You can see how the book gets smaller



To transfer the e-book you will need to attach your portable reader to the computer using the USB cord that came with your device. Once you have plugged it in, your reader should show up on bottom the left hand side of the screen.

The icon for your reader should appear with the name next to it, in this example it is the NOOK.

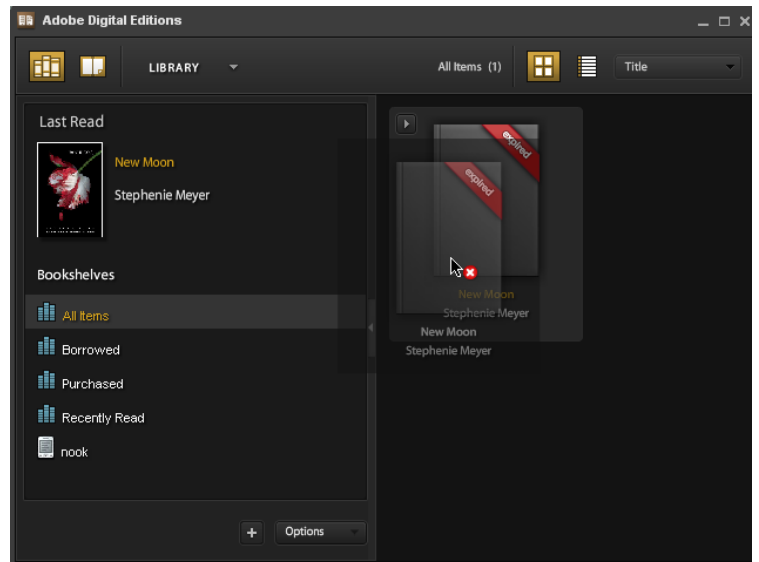


To transfer your e-book to your device, drag and drop it on your reader icon by clicking on the book with the left button of the mouse and hold it down. Move the mouse toward the icon of your reader. A copy of the book cover should appear to move with the mouse.

Move your e-book until it is right on top of the icon and name of your reader, then release the left button on the mouse. This should “drop” the e-book into the reader and you should see a brief “transferring book to reader” message.

Once the transfer is done the book should be loaded onto your reader and you will be able to view it on your reader for the remainder of your checkout period.

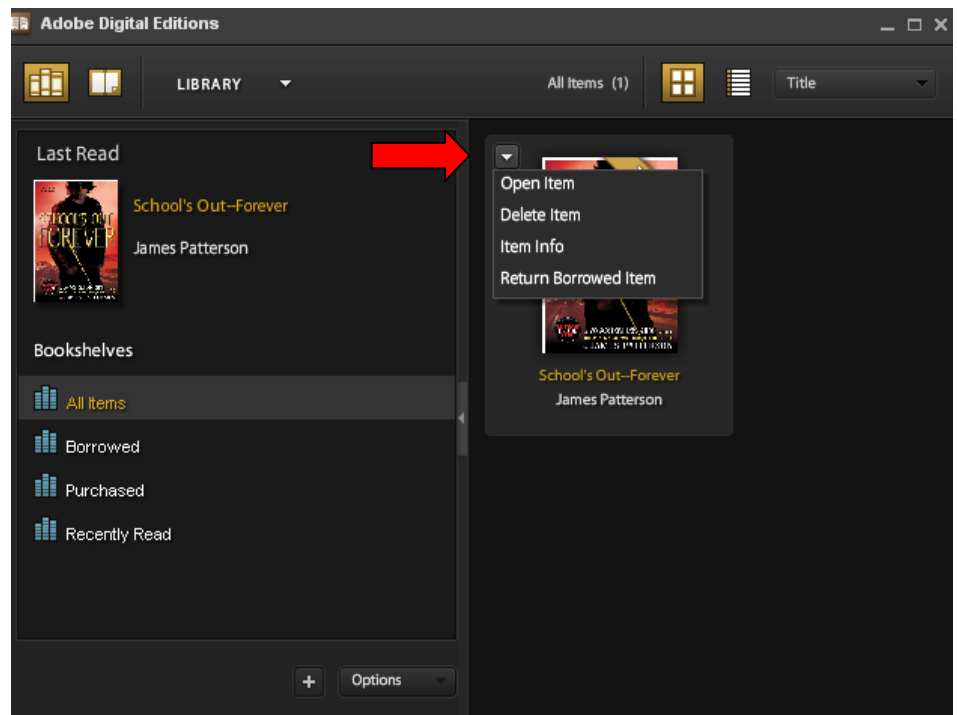
(NOTE for Sony Reader users: You MUST have the Sony Reader Library software on your computer for this to work with the Sony Reader. This should be included with the materials you got when you purchased your Sony reader, or it is available from ebookstore.sony.com)



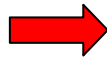
There are other things you can do in Adobe Digital Editions

The upper left corner of each book title has an arrow that appears when you move the mouse over it. From here you can

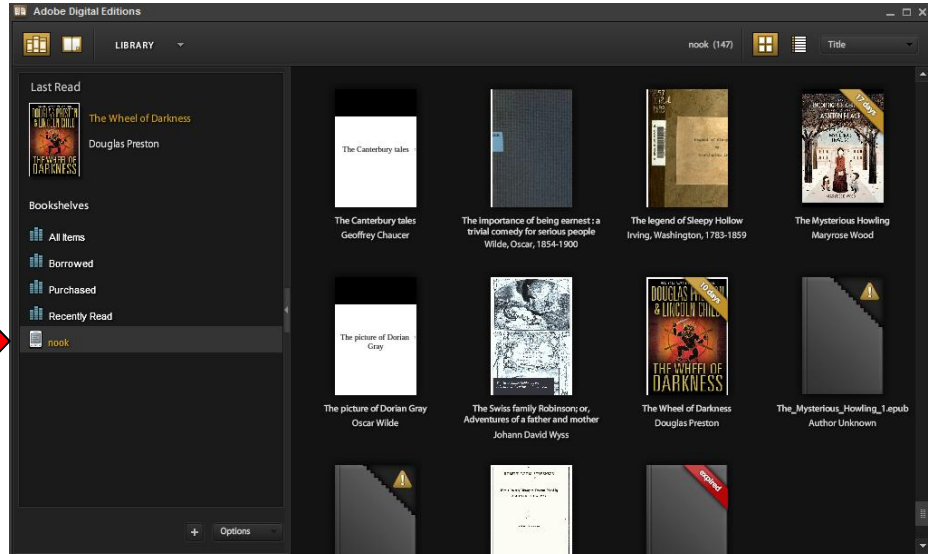
- open and read your e-book
- delete the e-book file,
- return your e-book early to Overdrive.



If you move your mouse and double click on your e-book reader icon you will see the items that are on your stored on your reader. This is where you can remove e-book files from your reader that you no longer need.



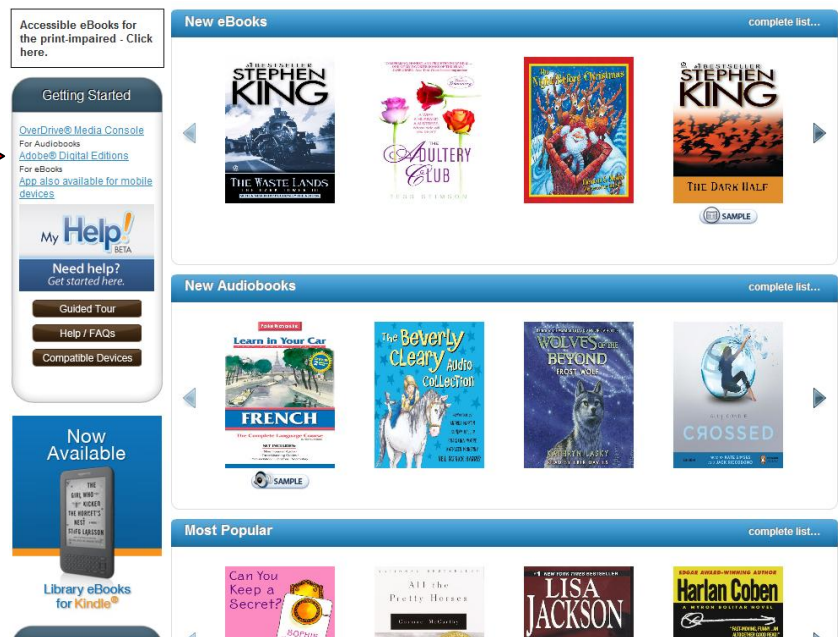
When you are done, close Adobe Digital Editions, disconnect your reader, and you should be ready to enjoy your e-book on your reader.



Download and install Adobe Digital Editions

FIRST TIME ONLY STEP: If this is your first time on your home computer, you will need to download and install the Adobe software on your computer before you can use the service.

Scroll down the Overdrive webpage until you see the free software section on the left-hand side. Click on the **Adobe Digital Editions** link to go to the page where you can download the software.

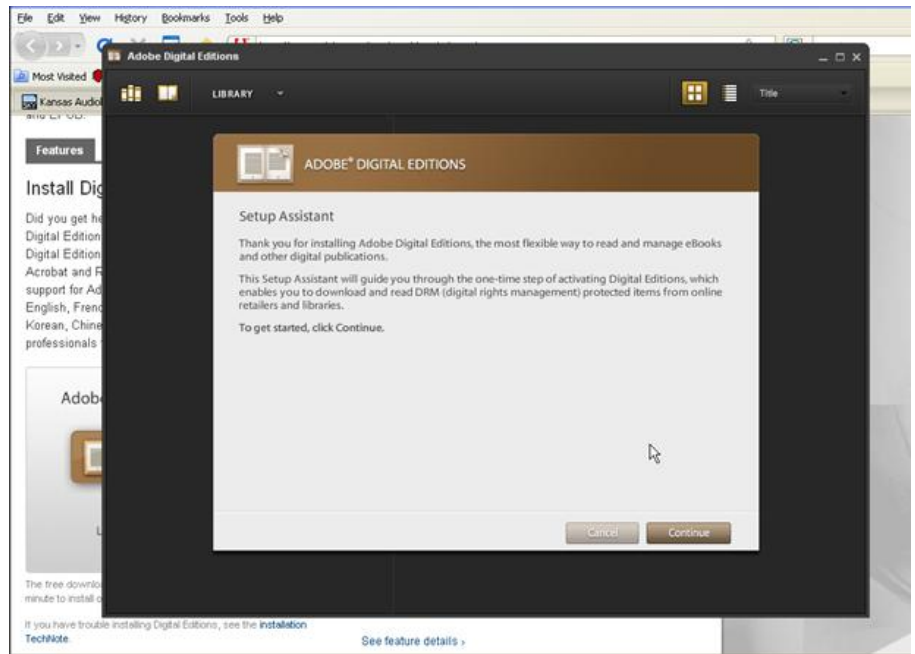

After you install the software, you should activate it with an Adobe Digital Editions ID. (This is REQUIRED if you are going to transfer book to an E-Reader device).

To activate Adobe Digital Editions using an Adobe ID...

Open Adobe Digital Editions. The 'Setup Assistant' dialog box is displayed.

Follow the on-screen instructions to set up your free Adobe Digital Editions account.



- Click 'Continue'. The 'Authorize Computer' screen is displayed.
- In the appropriate fields, enter the email address and password for your Adobe ID. If you do not already have an Adobe ID, click 'get an Adobe ID online' and follow the instructions to sign up for an Adobe ID.
- Click 'Activate'. Your computer is activated to your Adobe ID.
- Click 'Finish' to close the 'Setup Assistant' dialog box.
